

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed proposals addressed to the City Manager of the City of Seguin, Texas will be received at the Seguin City Hall, 205 North River, Seguin, Texas 78155, until **2:30 P.M., November 3, 2015 (CDST)** for the **Geronimo Creek Outfall Relocation**. Any bid received after closing time will be returned unopened. The bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at the Seguin City Hall at 3:00 p.m. Bids shall be submitted in a sealed envelope (8 ½" x 11" minimum), clearly marked as follows:

A construction pre-bid meeting will be held on October 27, 2015 at 2:00 P.M. at the south end (Dead End) of Seitz Road in Seguin. The pre-bid meeting is not mandatory.

Principal items of construction will include:

The installation of approximately 295 linear feet of 30" plant treated effluent main and a concrete creek outfall structure. All necessary appurtenances will be incorporated into the construction.

Each bid must be accompanied by a certified or cashier's check, or an approved bidders bond in an amount not less than 5% of the maximum total bid, payable to the City of Seguin, Texas without recourse, as a guarantee that the Bidder will enter into a contract and execute performance and payment bonds on the forms provided, within ten (10) days after the award of contract.

Plans and specifications may be examined without charge at Seguin City Hall. Bid Documents and Construction Drawings for the project may be viewed and downloaded free of charge (with the option to purchase hard copies) at www.civcastusa.com. Bidders must register on this website in order to view and/or download specifications, plans and other related documents for this project. Failure to do so may result in error in the Unit Bid Quantities and/or Bid Amounts.
