Water Outage Affecting Approximately 50 Customers *Main Broken by Cable/Internet Contractor*

SEGUIN, Texas – Approximately 50 City of Seguin water customers are currently affected by an outage in the area of Highway 123 and Joe Carrillo Boulevard.

Koennecke Elementary School is among those affected. The City of Seguin has contacted Seguin ISD about the situation. The Social Security Administration building, businesses and residents in the area are also affected.

Crews are working as quickly as possible to repair the break but the work is expected to take as long as 4-6 hours.

The outage is the cause of a water main break caused by a cable/internet provider working in the area.
