Entry Numbers 31-47 line up on E. Weinert Street, Enter from Milam Street

Entry Numbers 48-54 line up on W. Cedar Street, Enter from Camp Street

Entry Numbers 55-64 line up on E. Cedar Street, Enter from Milam Street

Entry Numbers 65-74 line up on W. Blumberg Street, Enter from Camp Street

Entry Numbers 75-88 line up on E. Humphreys Street, Enter from Milam Street

Entry Numbers 89-101 line up on E. Krezdorn Street, Enter from Milam Street

Entry Numbers 102-142 line up on E. College Street, Enter from King Street

A map identifying your location is included for your reference. Please enter the parade staging area from the street indicated above. All entries are to be lined up facing Austin Street.

IMPORTANT NOTES!!!!

- Entries with music should perform while passing by the V.I.P. Viewing Stands in Central Park.
- All entries **must be decorated!**
- It is important that gaps not develop along the parade route, meaning please do not stop to perform and if your entry can not keep up then you will be asked to step aside and let other entries pass.
- For everyone's safety, follow the parade route all the way to the 4-Plex parking lot behind the Coliseum before unloading passengers.
- If severe weather is a threat, listen to the KWED1580 for updates on the parade or visit the Seguin Main Street's Facebook page at www.facebook.com/SeguinMainStreet.

- If you are returning to the parade staging after the conclusion of the parade, please follow the following route to avoid traffic, north on Short Ave., west on Baker, north on Vaughn, east on Kingsbury, and south on Austin to your respective staging location.
- Read and follow the Parade Guidelines included for your reference.



PARTICIPANT RULES AND GUIDELINES

Important: this page must be copied and distributed to all unit participants. Failure to comply with these guidelines may result in dismissal from the parade and/or may affect future participation. Parade volunteers will monitor the parade route to assist if necessary. If you have any questions please call 830-401-2448 or 830-401-2475.

- *All entries are to be "Family-Friendly" and suitable for all audiences. Gory, vulgar and bloody entries will not be allowed.*
- *Flag protocol calls for all entries flying flags from other countries, cities or associations to have the American Flag posted first and prominent to any other flags.*
- ***All entries, including individual vehicles and horses in a club entry, must be decorated or they will not be allowed to participate.***
- *Car/Truck/Commercial Vehicles must limit participation to five (5) or fewer vehicles not exceed 100 feet in length. Multiple entries of same car clubs are not allowed. The city reserves the right to limit the number of car club entries.*
- *No extended blaring of loud air horns and sirens; intermittent please! TRAIN HORNS ARE NOT ALLOWED.*
- *Parade entries with people walking are not allowed, excluding marching units and marching bands, unless they have permission from the City of Seguin.*
- *Absolutely no items may be thrown during the parade including candy, gum, flowers, samples and water balloons, etc. This is a safety rule for participants and spectators.*
- *All performances must be conducted while moving. "Stand still" performances create lags in the parade and are not permitted. Keep the parade moving.*
- *Applicant ensures children (under 12 years of age) in parade unit will be adequately supervised from parade lineup to completion.*
- *Entries should be lined up by 9:00 a.m. Entries arriving late may be denied permission to participate in the parade and will not be judged.*
- *Judging will take place along the parade route beginning at 9:00 a.m. Three categories will be presented: Best Overall Entry, Best Local Entry, Most Unusual Entry and Most Patriotic Entry. Winners will be announced from the Grand Stand in Central Park and will be presented their trophy at that time.*
- *The distribution of any paper items during the parade is not permitted. This includes but is not limited to flyers, leaflets, coupons and brochures. Participants observed distributing said items will be asked to surrender them, and this may affect future participation.*
- *The use and/or possession during the parade of any alcoholic beverage is strictly forbidden.*
- *Water guns may not be used to spray the crowd. Water balloons may not be thrown from parade entries.*
- *Please maintain a distance of 2-3 car lengths between your entry and the one in front of you.*
- *All horse entries should provide a pooper-scooper and Coggin's test. Park and unload at least one block off the parade staging area and not on Camp, Milam or College Streets.*
- *The parade will end at the Coliseum/Fairgrounds. Parade participants are required to follow the entire parade route to the ballpark 4-plex on Nelda Street.*
- *Any entry deemed unsafe for any reason will not be allowed to participate.*
- *All entries are required to display the parade number that will be provided at the parade staging area.*
- *Protect yourself and those on your float from the sun and heat.*
- *Roller blades, skateboards, and scooters are not allowed on streets along the route during the parade.*
- *If you are asked to leave the parade route for any reason then you may not be allowed to return for the parade next year.*
- *Playing music too loud is not allowed. "Too loud" is determined by the parade official in charge.*
- *Playing music with vulgar lyrics and profanity is not allowed. Music must be suitable for a family audience.*
- *Maximum height is 13'6".*

ALL ENTRIES

- MUST BE DECORATED
- FOLLOW PARADE GUIDELINES INFORMATION SHEET
- DO NOT PARK VEHICLES, OTHER THAN THE OFFICIAL PARADE ENTRY, IN OR ALONG THE PARADE STAGING AREA
- PLEASE DROP OFF PARTICIPANTS AT THE INTERSECTION CLOSEST TO THE PARADE ENTRY

CAR CLUB AND TRUCK ENTRIES

- YOU MUST LIMIT PARTICIPATION TO FIVE OR FEWER VEHICLES
- ALL VEHICLES MUST BE DECORATED
- NO LOUD OR VULGAR MUSIC
- YOU MAY NOT STOP ALONG THE PARADE ROUTE
- EXHIBIT SAFE DRIVING AT ALL TIMES

HORSE ENTRIES

- COGGINS RESULTS REQUIRED
- DO NOT ALLOW HORSES ON PRIVATE PROPERTY
- PLEASE CLEAN-UP AFTER YOUR OWN ANIMAL(S) IN PARADE STAGING AND ALONG PARADE ROUTE
- PLEASE PROVIDE A POOPER SCOOPER CREW FOR YOUR ENTRY
- PARK AND UNLOAD ANIMALS AT LEAST ONE BLOCK AWAY FROM THE PARADE STAGING AREA. IF POSSIBLE UNLOAD AND DECORATE AT THE COLISEUM PARKING LOT
