

Detective Tony Vassar recognized as August Employee of the Month

SEGUIN, Texas – Every community needs individuals who are dedicated to helping others in need. Detective Vassar with the Seguin Police Department is one of those people, and that’s why he is the City of Seguin Employee of the Month for August.

“There’s no better place to work. Everyday. It’s awesome to be recognized,” said Vassar.

Detective Vassar was presented with a plaque and gift certificate by City Manager Doug Faseler and Police Chief Kevin Kelso on Tuesday, August 25th. Many of his colleagues were on-hand to congratulate him on the honor.

According to his nomination, Vassar was on his way home from work last May when he witnessed a man fall from his riding lawn mower. He turned around his vehicle, and stopped to help and checked his vital signs. The man was breathing, but unconscious. After calling for EMS, another off-duty detective with the Guadalupe County Sheriff’s Office also stopped to render aid. The two performed CPR until emergency responders arrived on-scene.

“Unfortunately, I was told this man did not survive the accident. He had a lot of health problems. However, his family posted on Facebook that they were able to have several hours of time with him before he passed away. I’m glad they had those extra moments to say goodbye” said Vassar.
