

Library Kicks Off Food For Fines Food Drive ***Donate a Can of Food to Reduce Overdue Fines***

SEGUIN, Texas – In the spirit of the season, the Seguin Public Library is sponsoring a food drive to benefit the Seguin Christian Cupboard. From November 24 through December 31, library members may donate nonperishable items in lieu of payment for overdue fines.

Here is how it works:

- One nonperishable item will be equivalent to up to \$2.50 in fines
- Donations may be applied to all accounts linked to the person (i.e., all members of the household)
- There is no maximum in the amount of fines forgiven as long as the member donates enough items to cover the dollar amount that has accrued in fines
- Donations may be used to forgive only existing fines and cannot be “banked” in anticipation of future fines
- Donations may not be used to forgive lost or damaged material charges
