Automotive Products

Antifreeze, batteries, brake fluid, motor oil and filters, fuels, vehicle batteries, polishes and waxes



Garden Chemicals

Fertilizers, herbicides, insect sprays, pesticides, weed killers and poisons



Household Chemicals

Ammonia, heavy-duty cleaners, tile cleaner, rust remover, hobby glue, and driveway sealer



Paint Products

Latex paint, oil-based paint, caulk, glue, stripper, stain, thinner, wood preservative and artist paint



Swimming Pool Chemicals

Chlorine tablets and liquids, pool acid and stabilizer



Household Items

Household batteries, thermometers, thermostats, compact fluorescent tubes (CFL) and straight fluorescent tubes

Sharps



(Sharps and needles must be placed in a sealed, rigid, puncture resistant container)



Electronics

Television, computer system, cell phones, desktop printers, fax machines, DVD/CD/Tape players and related cords
