1. Call to order.

3. Hearing of residents.

Discussion on how the review of the Seguin Animal Services facility and operations budget revealed the need for revisions for the 2012-2013 budget year. Captain Watson mentioned the proposal of implementing a spay/neuter voucher program, increasing the medical budget, and increasing the staff by one animal services officer.
