Notice of Milam Street Partial Closure *River/San Marcos/Heideke Project Continues*

SEGUIN, Texas – The City of Seguin wants to alert residents of upcoming partial street closures that are part of the River/San Marcos/Heideke Project.

Beginning Monday, May 5 at 8 a.m., the 100 and 200 blocks of North and South Milam Streets will be closed. This closure is expected to last between two and three weeks.

During this time, underground boring will take place on Court Street however Court Street will not be closed.
