Water Main Break Affecting Oak Village North Residents

Emergency Repairs Underway

UPDATE 4:19pm: Water service to Oak Village North has been restored. This fix is temporary. A permanent repair will need to be made in the near future. When that happens, notices will go out prior to the shut off.

Residents may notice some residual brown water when they first use faucets this evening. This will be temporary and should be solved by running the water in all faucets for a minute or two.

The City of Seguin thanks residents for their patience.

UPDATE 3:17pm: The break occurred as city crews were making upgrades to the line. Approximately 150 homes are currently affected.

ORIGINAL (2:41pm): SEGUIN, Texas – A water main break near the Ranch at 123 apartment complex is causing a disruption in service to residents of Oak Village North.

City crews are en route to make the necessary emergency repairs. Service is expected to be restored within four hours.

Reverse 911 calls are going out to affected residents.

Updated information will be provided as the situation unfolds.
