
MAX STARCKE PARK

★ Walking/Running

PECAN BOTTOM FITNESS TRAIL

1412 River Dr. East. Walk or jog this .8 mile trail through a shaded pecan grove with a multi-use fitness station. Dogs on leash allowed. In Max Starcke Park East.



TLU FITNESS TRAIL

Walk or jog on this .6 mile fitness trail around TLU's sports complex. Dogs on leash allowed but please pick up after them. Off Hwy 90 at Fleming Dr. on campus.



PARK WEST

Walnut Springs Trail connects with the Library and Walnut Springs Park, nature trails in Park West.



5K RUNS/WALKS

Each year during ArtsFest in March is the Color Me Nutty Fun Run. Other runs/walks for good causes take place throughout the year including the Moonlight Run.



★ Biking

TOUR DE PECAN

Each October during Pecan Fest, bikers come from all over to ride in this event that benefits Wounded Warriors.



BIKE TRAILS

There are plenty of bike trails in town from the Irma Lewis Outdoor Learning Center to the Pecan Bottom Trail to the Walnut Springs Trail that runs from Park West to the new Library. Also, try the new off-road bike trail at Park West.

LAKES

Lakes with public boating, paddling, skiing and fishing for catfish, spotted bass, crappie, sunfish, and largemouth bass.

Lake Placid - exit 605 off I-10 under the bridge. Boat ramp and public parking.
Lake Seguin - S. Austin St. in Max Starcke Park West. 4-mile paddling trail, fishing.
Meadow Lake - boating, fishing, paddling trails from 2.6 to 8.4 miles from Max Starcke Park East, River Shade RV Park or Nolte Dam.



★ Skateboarding

919 San Antonio Ave. Skaters will love the new Michael Thomas Raetzsch (MTR) Skatepark at Park West with its new plaza design. A great way to "Keep Seguin Rolling."



★ Golf Courses

MAX STARCKE PARK GOLF COURSE

650 River Dr. West • 830-401-2490. Open daily. Top-ranked 18-hole course along the river lined with mature pecan trees. Cart rental, pro shop, practice tees.



★ Wave Pool

MAX STARCKE PARK WAVE POOL

1 Wave Pool Dr., • 830-379-7665. Open Tues-Sun, June to August. Freshwater swim has four wave patterns, splash pool, tubes, water aerobics, swim lessons, shaded picnic tables, and snack bar.



★ Dog Park

BARKY PARK - 1400 River Dr. West at Max Starcke Park off S. Austin St. Separate fenced areas for small and large dogs. Waste bags, water for dogs, and benches. Lots of shade from the giant pecan trees and lots of space to run, fetch and play.



★ Playgrounds

Max Starcke Park East and Park West have new shaded play structures that are ADA accessible with picnic areas and grills. Manuel C. Castilla Park and Blumberg Park also have playscapes for the kids.



★ Birding

Grab your binoculars and find a spot at Walnut Springs Park, Park West, or Max Starcke Park to scope out the various birds in the area including red-tailed hawks, cardinals, golden-cheeked warblers, cranes, herons, and you might even spot a golden eagle.
