



# Reconciliation Issue #1 - SH 46 to SH 123



Guadalupe County	New Braunfels	Seguin
1. Extend FM 20 west from SH 123 to SH 46 as a 120-foot Major Arterial (R4 or U4M)	2. Widen Cordova Road to 4-lane, undivided Major Collector	5. New Outer Loop 6-lane, divided Parkway
4. SH 46 is a 120 foot wide Arterial	3. Huber Road is a 90-foot wide Arterial	6. New Inner Loop 4-lane, divided Parkway
	4. SH 46 is a 120 foot wide Arterial	7. Realign & widen Huber Rd to a 4-lane, divided Major Collector
		8. New Union Pacific Loop realigns Cordova west of Huber Road to Inner loop as a 2-lane collector
		9. Extend 8 <sup>th</sup> St outside of IH 10 to Inner Loop as a 2-lane collector
		10. Widen Guadalupe St, realigning north of Stempel St
		11. SH 46 and SH 123 are 6 lane divided Arterials

- Questions:**
1. Huber Road – New Braunfels’s 90-foot wide arterial would likely be an urban, undivided section (U4). Seguin’s is either a U4M or R4M requiring a 110- to 140-foot wide right-of-way. What should be the preferred section?
  2. Cordova Road conflicts with Seguin’s planned Union Pacific Loop. How should this be resolved?
  3. Is there a need for both the extended FM 20 and an improved Cordova Road? If not, which should be built? If so, what should they look like?
  4. New Braunfels specified 120-foot wide right-of-way for SH 46 is not wide enough for a six-lane, divided section (130 to 160 feet for urban and rural required). Should additional right-of-way be specified? Otherwise, should SH 46 be an undivided or alternative typical section?
