SEGUIN UNEMPLOYMENT DECREASES TO 6.1% IN MARCH

Workforce Solutions Alamo reports that the city of Seguin unemployment rate decreased to 6.1 percent in March, down from 6.4 percent reported in February.

The city of Seguin unemployment rate registered lower than the overall jobless rate of 6.6 percent reported for the San Antonio-New Braunfels Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA) comprised of Atascosa, Bandera, Bexar, Comal, Guadalupe, Kendall, Medina and Wilson counties.

Comparing the Workforce Solutions Alamo metro area to the state and nation, the Texas unadjusted (actual) unemployment rate decreased to 7.0 percent in March, down from 7.2 percent in February. The nation's unadjusted (actual) unemployment rate decreased to 8.4 percent in March, down from 8.7 percent reported for February. Comparatively, the state and nation release seasonally adjusted unemployment rates with Texas decreasing to 7.0 percent in March and the nation's unemployment rate decreasing to 8.2 percent.
