New Residential Curb-Side Recycling Service

The City of Seguin is moving forward with an initiative set forth by the Seguin City Council's Solid Waste Committee to implement a *Residential Curb-Side Recycling Service*. This recycling service will make recycling more convenient and manageable to our residential customers, and better enable them to help the environment, ease the strain on landfills, reduce contamination and litter, and return recyclables to commerce.

Residential Recycling Specifics:

- The City will begin servicing residential customers with weekly curb-side recycling collection beginning Tuesday, October 1, 2013.
- This service will be provided by Progressive Waste, the current waste disposal provider.
- An additional monthly fee of \$2.50 per household will be assessed on each residential monthly utility bill for this new service.
- Blue 65-gallon recycling containers will be delivered to residential customers beginning September 19th. Each recycling container will include a label with instructions and a list of items accepted. A flyer will be distributed along with the containers providing route and pickup information.

Due to this new recycling service, the Central Recycling Center located off Fred Byrd Drive will be permanently closed beginning October 1, 2013. Mulch will still be available for pickup at the current location off Fred Byrd Drive on a self-serve basis.

The City encourages all residential customers to take advantage of this new weekly *Curb-Side Recycling Service* and recycle as many things as possible.
