Public Input Sought for Skate Park Design

Design Input Meeting Set for September 18

SEGUIN, Texas – The City of Seguin is reaching out to the community for assistance designing the new skate park to be built on the city’s west side.

“This is a way for the people who will use this skate park to have a say in the design,” Seguin Parks and Recreation Director Jack Jones said. “We’re interested in hearing the amenities and features local skaters would like to see included.”

A design input meeting is scheduled for 6 p.m. Thursday, September 18 at the Seguin Coliseum. Representatives from SPA Skateparks, New Line Skateparks and Seguin Parks and Recreation will be on-hand to hear suggestions. All input will be considered but must fall within budgetary limitations.

“We hope this opportunity helps give the skaters a sense of ownership and pride in the skate park,” Jones continued. “We have a passionate community of skaters in Seguin and we want to make sure their voices are heard.”

The 2013 bond election provided \$5 million for park amenities that include a new community park on a 48-acre site located south of San Antonio Avenue and west of North Vaughan Avenue.
