

Improvements Coming to Max Starcke Park Tennis Courts

Resurfacing Project Begins July 14

SEGUIN, Texas – Tennis lovers in Seguin have something to look forward to. Renovations to the tennis courts at Max Starcke Park will soon provide an even better playing environment.

“Over the course of several years the surface of tennis courts wear down, crack and become uneven,” Seguin Parks and Recreation Director Jack Jones said. “This project will create an entirely new playing service that will greatly benefit the people who use the courts.”

Work to resurface the six courts will begin Monday, July 14. Each court will be painted with U.S.T.A. regulation white lines. Two of the courts will also have 60 foot blended lines for youth ten and under play. After the resurfacing is complete, new windscreens will be added to cover all of the ten foot fences that surround the courts. The \$22,100 project has been awarded to American Sports & Concrete and is the first to utilize money approved in the November 2013 bond package.

“We’re looking forward to getting this project underway,” Seguin Assistant Director of Parks and Recreation Crystal Miranda said. “It’s the first chance for voters to see the park bond money at work.”

The courts will be closed while the work is underway. The resurfacing project is expected to take approximately two weeks, depending on weather conditions. The courts were last resurfaced about five years ago.
