Utility Crew

The utility crew will begin utility work along the North and South sides of Spanish Oak, including installing sewer services.

Sewer installation will resume along Twin Oak near the White Oak intersection.

When the utility crew has reached the intersection at Twin Oak/White Oak, the majority of traffic will be diverted to Lone Oak

upon arrival at the subdivision entrance.

Detour signs will be placed on-site and for your safety.

Street Crew

The street crew will begin construction along White Oak.

Curb Crew

The curb crew will continue ribbon curb construction on Twin Oak.
