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Contractor completes major manhole installation



and Red Oak. The manhole set at this intersection was approximately 29' in depth. This depth required extensive excavation work as well as hauling off spoil material. Completion of the manhole work at this depth is considered a major milestone in the project.

Construction will now progress west on Twin Oak up to Manhole 8. The

contractor will then return to Manhole 4 on Red Oak and proceed north onto Lone Oak.

REMEMBER, THAT THE DEPTH SHOULD BE DETERMINED BY A LICENSED PLUMBER. ALSO, THE LOCATION MUST BE AT THE PROPERTY LINE.. THE CITY WILL NOT INSTALL THE NEW SEWER TAP INSIDE PRIVATE PROPERTY.
