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Project Update

- October 16, 2013: Jordan Foster confirmed they will have two utility crews assigned to the project. The crews will work simultaneously throughout the neighborhood to expedite utility repairs and complete the project. Residents can expect to see heavy equipment, dump trucks, material trucks etc., over the next several months and watering of the roads for dust control will continue. Trash and recyclable collections and mail delivery should not be interrupted. **If you experience a problem with these items, please contact Capital Projects at (830) 401-2776. **Please adhere to all detours and barricades****
- October 18, 2013: As per the suggestion of Cara Nell Decker at the October 15, 2013, City Council meeting, a large magnet has been purchased, delivered and mounted to the front of the City's street sweeper in an effort to pick up any remaining nails left on the street. The magnet has been tested and is successfully being used in the neighborhood. Following this initial use in the subdivision, the magnet will remain on the street sweeper and used regularly on the sweep routes throughout the City.
- October 21, 2013: Jordan Foster will have a survey crew in the neighborhood to survey existing conditions. Please note, all City vehicles and personnel and its consultants and/or agents are properly identified with placards indicating their respective company name. *Any suspicious activity should be reported to Seguin Police Department dispatch at (830) 379-2123.*
- October 21-23, 2013: The Public Works crew worked to remove the large rocks on the road in the subdivision.
- October 23, 2013: All Points Inspection video taped the remaining sewer services.
- October 28, 2013: Jordan Foster will begin utility work.
 - ⇒ Crew 1 will begin at the bridge in the 300-block of Twin Oak and Spanish Oak. Residents on the east side of the bridge will need to utilize the detour road to enter and exit the subdivision. Minor repairs will be made on the detour road prior to closing down the bridge.
 - ⇒ Crew 2 will begin at Red Oak Court, and work north towards Twin Oak. Travel lanes will be set up adjacent to the work area.
