Project Update

• Crews:

Due to the weather forecasts this past week, the contractor chose not open the trench at the Twin Oak Bridge. However, the contractor will begin work at this location on Monday, November 11th. The bridge will be closed down and motorists will be routed to the detour road. Work will continue over the next couple of weeks.

Adjustments continue on a shallow line at the Red Oak and Twin Oak intersection and at South Red Oak.

• Surveying:

There will be a survey crew working this weekend to verify manhole elevations (no trench/repair work will be taking place).

• Residential Repairs:

Installing a new sewer service tap at 109 Twin Oak.

Two driveways along Red Oak are being replaced due to changes in stormwater flow and incorrect drain pipe elevations.

◇ The contractor will work on Monday, November 11, 2013 (Veteran's Day). An inspector will be on site.

• Reminders:

- ◇ Please adhere to all detours and barricades.
- ◇ The City's Electric Department will be in the neighborhood trimming trees. The contractor is National Tree Experts. At times, requests may be made to gain access to non-accessible areas. If you have questions regarding the tree trimming activities, you may contact Utilities Dispatch at (830) 401-2404.
- ◇ Trash pick up is on Tuesday and Recyclable pick up is on Thursday.
- ◇ Brush service will be in the area the week of November 18-22, 2013.
- ◇ If you experience a problem with trash and recyclable collections and/or mail delivery, please contact Capital Projects at (830) 401-2776.
- ◇ **City Hall will be closed on Monday, November 11, 2013, in observance of Veteran's Day.**
