PROJECT UPDATE:

Saturday, March 22nd

NO WORK SCHEDULED

Week of March 24th—28th

Dirt crews will finish the road base and grade earthen channels along Burr Oak, Spanish Oak and east Twin Oak.

Asphalt paving is scheduled to take place the first week of April in these areas. It is critical that all vehicles remain off the street during this process. The operation will consist of OILING the street, spreading the asphalt and final compaction of the asphalt. The area will require at a minimum, two (2) hours after the final compaction, to cool down prior to the return of vehicle traffic.

Be advised, that once the OIL is on the street, you will **NOT** be allowed to drive or utilize the street, unless it is an absolutely necessary.

Failing to adhere could result in your tires tracking the oil onto the paint of your vehicle.

Concrete crews will work along Twin Oak and Red Oak installing new driveway aprons and performing driveway repairs.

Sewer utility testing will continue throughout the subdivision and City crews will continue to tie-in the new water lines.

Other News:

Information regarding the 319(H) Grant (septic tank decommission) process will be forthcoming from the Planning/Codes Department in mid-to-late Spring.

REMINDERS:

For the safety of the neighborhood and workers, please drive with caution and adhere to all detours and barricades.

To ensure regularly scheduled garbage and/or recycle pick up, containers should be placed out the night before or prior to 6:00 a.m. the morning of collection. Progressive has adjusted their route schedule due to the construction and times may vary week to week. If your trash or recyclables is missed, please call (830) 401-2776 or (830) 401-2445 as soon as possible. *Be advised, a work order to return for a missed pickup may take up to 24 hours to complete.*
