****NO WORK SCHEDULED****

WEEK OF APRIL 28th - MAY 2ND

****WEATHER PERMITTING****

The contractor will be oiling every street that has not received asphalt beginning, **Monday, April 28th and Tuesday, April 29th**. Once the oil is administered, it will need a minimum two (2) hours to cure. Following the curing process, the contractor will sand over the oil. This method may take up to three (3) to four (4) hours to complete. **During this time, vehicular traffic is not recommended.**

Street paving is scheduled for **Thursday, May 1st and Friday, May 2nd**. Once the paving machine has completed the paving in and around your area, it will need two (2) to three (3) hours to cool and therefore, vehicular traffic will be **prohibited**.

Miscellaneous driveway and drainage work continues throughout the subdivision.
