Project Update

- **Saturday, January 11th**
A ground crew *may* be on site cleaning the sewer main near the Twin Oak and Red Oak intersection and in areas near Spanish Oak.
- **Week of January 20th - 24th**
 - ⇒ One utility crew will begin repair work near the main entrance at Martindale Road. During the day, this area of Twin Oak will be reduced to one lane traffic. The area will return to two lane traffic in the evenings. *****Please adhere to the lane delineation and flagmen in this area.*****
 - ⇒ The second utility crew will begin work between 216 and 230 Twin Oak.
 - ⇒ Street work will also continue at Burr Oak and at the east side of the Twin Oak bridge. Anticipate haul trucks through the neighborhood during this time.

REMINDERS:

- ⇒ **City Hall will be closed Monday, January 20th, 2014, in observance of the Martin Luther King, Jr. holiday.**
- ⇒ Driveway and curb repairs will be addressed during the street portion of the project, which will be performed after the utility portion is complete.
- ⇒ Please adhere to all detours and barricades.
- ⇒ The City's Electric Department continues with trimming trees in the subdivision. The contractor is National Tree Experts. At times, requests may be made to gain access to non-accessible areas. If you have questions regarding the tree trimming activities, you may contact Utilities Dispatch at (830) 401-2404.
- ⇒ To ensure regularly scheduled garbage and/or recycle pick up, containers should be placed out the night before or prior to 6:00 a.m. the morning of collection. Progressive has adjusted their route schedule due to the construction and times may vary week to week. If your trash or recyclables is missed, please call (830) 401-2776 or notify by email as soon as possible. *Be advised, a work order to return for a missed pickup may take up to 24 hours to complete.*
