## Project Update

- **Saturday, January 25th**
  - ⇒ The crews will not work this weekend.
- **Week of January 27th - 31st**
  - ⇒ The utility crew will continue working along the 200 block of Twin Oak working towards White Oak, at approximately mid-block. A second utility crew will begin testing all sewer locations that have been repaired.
  - ⇒ The curb trencher and concrete crews will begin working along Burr Oak and the east side of the bridge at Twin Oak and Spanish Oak. You will also see the dirt crews repairing the road base in the locations of the sewer repairs as well.
  - ⇒ *The City has received several requests from residents on a completion timeline/schedule for the project. Staff is in discussion with the contractor to determine a precise timeline, within reason (given the recent inclement weather conditions in the area). We are hopeful to provide a completion date schedule estimate within the next couple of weeks along with information on recent video and testing.*
  - ⇒ **Email Advisory:** The City of Seguin is currently experiencing problems with sending emails to person who have email service with AT & T, SBC Global and/or any provider associated with AT & T. AT & T is not recognizing the City of Seguin as a safe domain for its users. Therefore, if you know of someone that receives email through an AT & T provider, it is for this reason they may not be receiving the most recent newsletter.
