

Water Quality Report Public Meeting Scheduled *Annual Drinking Water Quality Report Available*

SEGUIN, Texas – The City of Seguin is providing residents the opportunity to inquire about the annual drinking water quality report during a public meeting this week.

The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) requires community water systems to put annual drinking water quality reports into the hands of their customers. These reports (also known as consumer confidence reports) were developed in consultation with water suppliers, environmental groups and states to enable Americans to make practical, knowledgeable decisions about their health and their environment. The 2013 Seguin drinking water quality report was mailed out last week.

The public meeting is scheduled for Thursday, July 10 from 5:15 – 6:15 p.m. in the Seguin City Council Chambers at 210 East Gonzales Street. The report is available by going to www.seguintexas.gov, clicking “departments,” then “water/wastewater utilities.” The report is then available under the “water plant” link.
