1. Call to Order.

The meeting was called to order at 5:54 p.m. by Chair Andrea Hoffmann.

5. Discussion and possible action on a request from Guadalupe County on parking needs surrounding the Courthouse – Kyle Kramm, Director of Main Street Program.

Kyle Kramm reported that Guadalupe County has requested for the two hour parking to be eliminated in the 100 block of East Court and 100 block of South River, maintaining the Sherriff's parking in the 100 block of South Austin and the elected officials parking in the 100 block of East Donegan. Staff recommended approving all of their request except the removal of the two hour parking in the 100 block of South River. Hepzibah Hoffman-

Rogers made a motion to approve staff's recommendation. Robert Etlinger seconded the motion, the motion carried unanimously.

6. Discussion on PecanFest and Hats Off to Juan Seguin 2016 – Kyle Kramm, Director of Main Street Program.


